



Cressex Business Park BID Updates



ANPR Cameras now installed

As part of a significant investment by the BID, ANPR (Automatic Number Plate Recognition) cameras have now been installed at key points of the businesses park. This project delivers on a key commitment from the Cressex BID Proposal, creating an attractive and secure environment for business.

Working in partnership with Thames Valley Police, the cameras will form part of the wider national ANPR network, which helps deter criminal activity. For businesses on Cressex this investment helps to strengthen security, support police in tackling crime and create a safer environment for all employees.

Landscape Features

The BID team is developing plans to enhance key gateway areas with green space improvements and biodiversity-rich planting. These upgrades aim to improve the look and feel of the area while supporting wildlife, air quality, and a more welcoming environment for residents, visitors, and businesses.

Initial focus will be on the entrances to Lincoln Road, Halifax Road, and Wellington Road, with proposals including sustainable planting and greener streetscapes. Further updates and details will be shared as the project progresses.

Cressex Business Park's New Lamp Post Banners

Thank you for submitting your logos for our Lamp Post Banner Campaign, the banners will be installed within the next 6 weeks.

Winter Maintenance

To help keep Cressex Business Park safe and accessible during the winter months, Nationwide Gritters have been actively gritting and salting key side roads off Coronation Road and Lancaster Road, including Lincoln, Wellington, Halifax, and Turnpike Roads.

Throughout the colder period, a total of 11 gritting visits were carried out - 7 in January and 4 in February, targeting times of low temperatures and increased risk of ice. This proactive approach has helped reduce hazardous driving and walking conditions, supporting safer journeys for employees, visitors, and deliveries.

Business Park Cleaning

Great News! We have had confirmation that Cressex is being changed from a street zone 3 to 2, this will result in a higher frequency of cleansing in the area: regular scheduled mechanical sweeping and litter picking occur every 3 weeks, instead of every 6 weeks.

A404

The BID has been actively engaging with Bucks Highways, National Highways, the Council, Ward Councillors and local MPs Emma Reynolds and Joy Morrissey, and we're pleased to see this collaborative effort deliver results with the A404 corridor now included in a recent Road Investment Strategy (RIS3) update, see here for the report: [Road Investment Strategy 3 \(RIS3\): 2026 to 2031](#). The BID Manager will continue to work closely with all parties, lobbying for further practical improvements - including quicker wins such as enhanced signage to Cressex Business Park on the approach to, and within, High Wycombe.
