Dear Business,

This leaflet is being sent to you in conjunction with your annual levy bill for the Cressex Business Park (CBP) Business Improvement District (BID). The BID was voted for by eligible businesses in July 2022 and came into effect on 1st October 2022, running through to 29th September 2027.

The BID Business Plan sets out a suite of projects and initiatives specifically designed for Cressex Business Park. The key themes are:

- 1. Getting Cressex Moving Improving Transport and Reducing Congestion
- 2. Creating an Attractive and Secure Environment for Business
- 3. Supporting Businesses and Investing in Employees

The BID is managed through an elected executive Board made up of CBP Businesses and associated stakeholders.

Projects and Services Supported and/or Funded by the BID in year 2 include:

- 1 Improving Transport and Reducing Congestion
- Progression with the options for access/egress into CBP, working in conjunction with relevant stakeholders.
- Escalating congestion issues with Buckinghamshire Council with agreement to review roadwork operations and management.
- Pro-active transport updates via one.network.
- Development of improved winter gritting services to reduce traffic congestion risks during winter weather conditions.
- Review of available parking and current options for businesses including permits, CPZ (Controlled Parking Zone) and addressing safety concerns.

- addressing issues with the Local Authorities.
- 2 Creating an Attractive & Secure Environment for 3 Supporting Businesses and Investing in **Business**
- Delivery of enhanced litter picking resulting in over 300 bags of waste collected and disposed.
- Development of a new signage and wayfinding scheme for Cressex Business Park. The scheme has now been approved by planning authorities and is expected to be installed during 2025.
- Development of plans for landscaped features to be implemented in the coming year and associated maintenance arrangement to sustain landscaped features.

- Proactive review of road markings and potholes, Implementation of the Cressex Business Park DISC Watch group.

 - Quarterly Sustainability Group meetings including networking and sharing of best practice with Globe Business Park BID companies, and invited guests.
 - Business engagement events with Buckinghamshire Business First Advisors.
 - News updates via CBP newsletter, website and social media.
 - Bi-monthly guided walks open to all businesses for health, wellbeing and networking.

Projects for coming year 2024/25 include:

- 1 Improving Transport and Reducing Congestion
- Access and egress solutions for vehicular movements. Working with associated agencies and appointed transport consultant to engage with technical specialists.
- Review of existing car parking facilities with relevant stakeholders.
- Zip car services offering flexible car use for businesses.
- 2 Creating an Attractive & Secure Environment for **Business**
- Walking maps with local information and points of interest.

- Retaining local talent providing an Enterprise Advisor to work with local schools, colleges and universities.
- Continued improvement of the CBP BID website, future projects to include a site wide interactive map.

The BID is managed by Groundwork South who are the BID Body. All businesses have an opportunity to put forward representatives to sit on the Board of levy payers which has a responsibility for providing strategic leadership and governance for the BID Body in the management of funds.
